BACKGROUND

In 1975, Don McMillan established one of the first economic development corporations in Canada – the Nanaimo Community Employment Advisory Society (NCEAS). NCEAS received national and international attention as a model for community development and is often credited with helping to establish the national CED program now known as Community Futures.

GUIDELINES

To be awarded to an individual Community Futures staff member or volunteer, or group of staff members or volunteers, in recognition of an outstanding contribution to community development.

Eligible Submissions

- Outstanding contribution to the development of a Community Futures program.
- Promoting and encouraging the partnering of community social and economic development agencies.
- Developing a successful CED initiative to assist a particular group or segment of the community.
- Notable contribution of promoting CED.
- Notable contribution of promoting or enhancing CED training.

Scales of Merit

The selection committee will review each submission and award points according to:

- Importance to long-term strategies of the Community Futures Program
- Impact on local economy
- Raising local skill levels
- Creativity and vision
- Benefit to the development of the community and/or segment of the community
